

10 Day Prayer Guide

Following the 2024 Election

"If my people, who are called by my name, humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

2 Chronicles 7:14

While the U.S Presidential Election is of great consequence, the prayers of the saints are of even greater consequence. This is a non-partisan kingdom-come Prayer Guide written prior to the election. This Prayer Guide is designed for you to use for the 10 days immediately following the 2024 U.S. elections, and it follows the Lord's prayer pattern.

Day 1. November 5, 2024 "Our Father"

Today is election day, perhaps the most significant election day in our lifetime. Declare the love of God the Father over our nation, over every voting booth, every precinct, and every person involved in counting the vote. Declare the love of God the Father over those who voted for your candidate, and those who didn't. God bless America, God shed His grace on thee.

Day 2. November 6, 2024 "Hallowed Be Your Name"

Regardless of which candidate won the election, Jesus is Lord. There is only one throne in the universe, and Jesus is seated on it. Declare the glory of God's name over our nation and over our future. All worship is responding appropriately to God's Name. Without asking for anything, declare over our nation today, "Hallowed Be Your Name!"

Day 3. November 7, 2024 "Your Kingdom Come"

Declare the coming of Christ's kingdom over the Oval Office, over the Senate and the Congress, and over the United States of America. Ultimately it is not the kingdom of the Democrats nor the Republicans, but the kingdom of Christ that matters. One day the kingdom of this world will become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ and he shall reign forever and ever (Revelation 11:15).

Day 4. November 8, 2024 "On Earth As It Is In Heaven"

Jesus told us, "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness and all these things will be added to you," (Matthew 6:33). Take time today to declare the coming of Christ's kingdom

on earth over our nation, as it is in heaven. Receive the Kingdom; it is full of repentance, humility, honor, justice, mercy, righteousness, and the knowledge of God.

Day 5. November 9, 2024 "Give Us Today Our Daily Bread"

God has been generous with America, and believers in America have been financially generous with the nations. God's word exhorts us, "First of all, then, I urge that... prayers... be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life," (1 Timothy 2:1-2). This "peaceful and quiet life" includes prayer for financial provision and financial integrity. Receive God's mercy, kindness, and provision as you pray today.

Day 6. November 10, 2024 "Forgive Us Our Debts"

"God bless America; God shed His grace on thee." God knows we are a sinful nation, and there is plenty of sin to go around. We as God's people are called to confess our sins and to plead for God's mercy. "If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land," (2 Chronicles 7:14). Take time today to confess both your personal sin and our corporate national sin. Be specific. Pride. Adultery and spiritual adultery. Greed. Deceit and deception. Idolatry and false religions. Materialism and baalism.

Day 7. November 11, 2024 "As We Forgive Our Debtors"

Asking God for his forgiveness for your sins is important; forgiving others of their sins is also essential for effective prayer. Take time right now to think of people who have offended, hurt, or abused you. Just as Christ has forgiven you for your sins, it is your privilege to now extend forgiveness to others.

Day 8. November 12, 2024 "Lead Us Not Into Temptation"

We all face two enemies—sin and Satan. Today is your day to declare victory over sin and temptation. Stand your ground. Take your position in Christ. Declare the victory of Christ over sin on your behalf and on behalf of our nation.

Day 9. November 13, 2024 "Deliver Us From Evil and the Evil One"

We have two enemies—sin and Satan. Yesterday we declared the victory of Christ over sin; today it is our privilege to declare victory over Satan, in Jesus' name. The devil is out to steal, kill, and destroy our nation (John 10:10). Keep in mind, "the reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil" (1 John 3:8). "He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world" (1 John 4:4). Christ is our righteous stronghold. Our fortress. Our Hiding

Place. Our Defender. Take your stand in Christ. Bind the power of evil. Loose the power of righteousness.

Day 10. November 14, 2024 "Yours Is the Kingdom, Power, and Glory"

God makes no mistakes. He is sovereign; He is good; and we can trust him. Every day of our 10 Day Prayer Guide we have been receiving from Christ. Today, on our final day, we want to give it all back to Him. Today is our day to declare, "yours is the kingdom, yours is the power, and yours is the glory forever and ever! Amen." Take your stand before the throne and declare His kingdom, glory, and power over our nation. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. Praise the Lord.
